

Golfview Hills Men's Golf League

As a result of a couple happenings the past few weeks, the following is a summary of our policy on scoring league competition..

Due to the nature of our hybrid medal/ match competition the "rules of golf" sometimes complicate our game and consequent scoring.

Failure to finish a hole: This happens at least 2 times every year, usually subs. We should all know what's at stake to advise them of their options.

A.) In Medal Play:

1. Results in forfeiture of all possible medal play, **10 points** (4 for stroke play, 4 for avg. and 2 point bonus for sweep).
2. Quota (\$\$\$\$\$), Remember the most a bad hole can cost you in the quota is -1.
3. Leaves a complicated calculation of handicap differential. You will be given a par + any handicap strokes you may have gotten in a normal stroke allocation. (I.E. a 12 would become a **4** if you received 1 stroke on a par 3. thus lowering your adj.gross. In lieu of the **7, 8, 9, or 10** you would have been allow in ESC). In most cases this will result in a lowering your handicap index. You only screw yourself.
4. Most of all this creates a lot of work and makes you very unpopular with Rich.

B.) In Match Play:

1. You forfeit that hole (2 points). And it creates a complicated manual adjustment to determine the correct holes won score to be used. See # 4 above.

Failure to record scores, or turn in a correct scorecard will be treated the same as above: This happen 3 or 4 times a year - usually the same league members. You know who you are.

1. No scorecard at the clubhouse, you're not in the competition. Giving your scores to someone else (in your foursome or not in your foursome) to turn in doesn't protect you if they are not turned in. Points will be counted if original card is received by 5pm the next day. If no card is turned in at all, everyone on the card loose everything. Handicap will be entered as par + course handicap.
2. Missing scores, you forfeit medal (10 points), and reduction of match play points. Missing holes will be scored as #3 above for handicapping only.
3. In all cases you are DQ in quota.

Wrong scores in card turned in are not reversible.

Exception: I.E. (A 5 that looks like a six will be changed if both parties agree.)

A score that was recorded as 6 that was really a 5, is now really a 6. A 6 that was record as 5, you are now DQ'd in Medal Play and Match play will be scored as above.

Each player is responsible for the accuracy of his score on the scorecard that is submitted.
